

Subject: The Pre-game Conference

Lesson Objective:

The students will be able to conduct a complete pre-game conference with their fellow officials.

Equipment and Materials to Teach the Lesson:

Normal classroom setting, including overhead projector, screen, transparencies, lesson plan and notes.

Approximate Time Needed:

45 minutes.

Learning Set:

Ask the students to think about what it would be like if the referee and linesmen never talked together before a game. What sort of problems would they have, etc.

Information: Facts, Concepts, Skills to be Taught:

See the Notes pages accompanying the transparency originals.

Strategies to Actively Involve the Participants:

When discussing the pre-game conference, ask the referees some of the things they would do in this phase of the conference.

Closure:

Ask the referees to tell their neighbor the most important thing they learned from the lesson and why. Get some of the referees to tell you what they told their neighbor.
